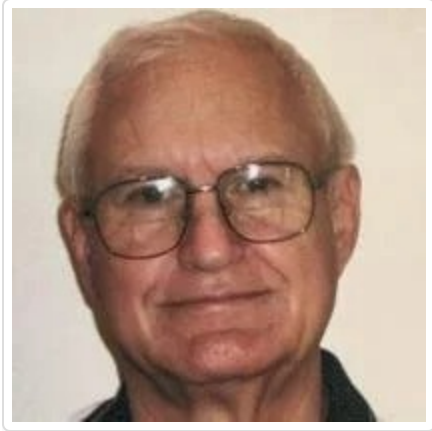




Brian Cooper Kent

Brian Cooper Kent, 78, of Neptune, NJ passed away on Wednesday November 9, 2016 at the Jersey Shore University Medical Center, Neptune. After graduation he enlisted in the United States Army and made it a career for 20 years before retiring in 1974 as Master Sergeant.
