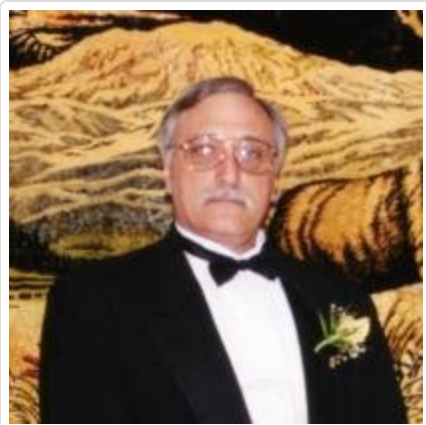




Joseph C. Centanni

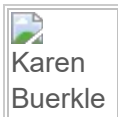
