Roberta M. Bamrick (née Carse), 94, entered eternal life on August 29, 2021 surrounded by her loving family in Continuing Care at The Gardens, Seabrook Village, Tinton Falls.

Roberta, lovingly referred to as “Bert” “Bobbie” “Grandma Bobbie” and “Grammie”, was born and raised in Kearny, NJ before moving to Spotswood, NJ with her husband Gerald to raise their family. After Gerald’s death, Roberta moved to Howell, NJ, then settled at Seabrook Village in Tinton Falls, NJ where she lived independently for the past 17 years.

Nursing was a true calling for Roberta. After her graduation from Queen of Peace High School in North Arlington, NJ, she enrolled in Holy Name Hospital School of Nursing in Teaneck, NJ, and was a member of The United States Cadet Nurse Corps that provided for her nurses training during WWII. Over the course of her long career, she worked at Presbyterian Hospital in Newark, NJ, St. John’s Hospital in Santa Monica, CA, Perth Amboy Hospital in Perth Amboy, NJ, Dr. Harold Cano MD’s office in Spotswood, NJ, Immaculate Conception School as the school nurse in Spotswood, NJ, and the Middlesex County Health Department as the Director of the Lead Poisoning Screening Program. Beyond the love and care that she gave at work, Roberta also cared for others through her many volunteer positions as a Cub Scout leader, a PTA member at ICS, a chair of the Catholic Council at Seabrook Village, a Welcome Ambassador at Seabrook, a Eucharistic Minister, a Hospice

Volunteer with the VNA of Central NJ, a Mercy Corp Volunteer at Holy Angels in Belmont, NC, and many more.

Roberta was a loving and devoted wife to Gerald for 34 years, forever in her heart and gone too soon at the age of 59. She was an incredible mother to her 6 children, awesome grandmother to her loving grandchildren and great grandchildren. Roberta was a devoted friend to many and has kept in touch with friends from all avenues of her life in her 94 beautiful years. During her entire life, she embodied everything that is good in this world, a devout and faithful Catholic, she taught us all that kindness counts, give it everything you've got in everything you set out to accomplish, prayer is a powerful tool and don't forget to count your blessings.

Roberta was predeceased by her husband Gerald Bamrick; son Michael Bamrick; parents Robert J. and Catherine Doherty Carse; and siblings George Carse and Kevin Carse.
