William Doll of Ocean Township, formally of North Bergen and Bradley Beach, passed away Tuesday January 7, 2014 at the Jersey Shore Medical Center in Neptune. Born and raised in Jersey City, Bill served his country proudly in the United States Navy as a parachute rigger from 1951 to 1955. He settled in North Bergen after service and was appointed to the North Bergen Police Force. Bill was a Police Honor Legion recipient and a decorated police officer retiring in 1991 with the rank of Lieutenant.
